

Creativity Prompt

PICASSO PORTRAITS

Description

Use simple shapes as a starting point to explore creativity and perspective with visual art.

Time to Complete

5-10 minutes

Materials

Paper, pen or pencil, Optional: colored pencils, crayons, markers

Instructions

Draw one of the following shapes on your paper (about the size of your palm): Circle, Square, or Triangle.

Now, using that shape, draw your self-portrait. Let the shape inspire and inform your portrait. This does not need to be a literal portrait. Be creative! Add more funky shapes or colors. Use words or include drawings of things you enjoy, or quotes you love. This is all about you.

There is no right or wrong way to complete this work of art. Art is all about perspective and the only one that matters is yours!

After you have finished your portrait, pick one thing that you really like about your portrait.
